2025/Apr/8 Play Area Equipment Replacement – Review of Quotations and Decision

Purpose of Report

To present councillors with quotations received for replacement play equipment, following the identification of worn out units and a request from the pre school for a train themed play unit and a younger child tower.

Background

- Several existing play units are now worn out and require replacement.
- There is limited provision for younger children in the current play area.
- The pre school has requested:
 - A train themed play unit to replace the condemned Jeep unit
 - A tower type unit suitable for younger children.
- Four companies were invited to quote; three responded.

Quotations Received

1. Outdoor Play People Total: £16,229 Discounted total (Royal Cornwall Discount, expires mid April 2026): £15,500
2. Piran Services Total: £25,037
3. Sovereign Play Total: £14,197.84

Key Considerations

- Outdoor Play People offer a bespoke Halwill Junction station theme.
- Sovereign Play is the lowest cost.
- Outdoor Play People's discounted price expires mid April 2026.

2. Request revised designs or further information from one or more suppliers.
3. Approve only part of the scheme at this stage.
